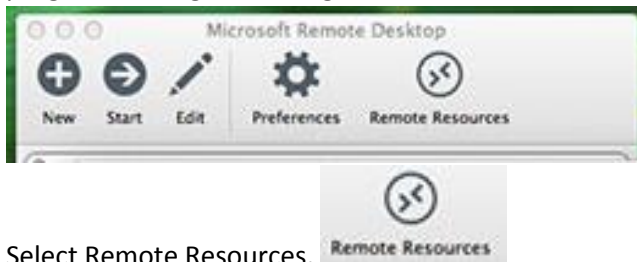


## Microsoft Remote Desktop Applications for Mac

Use this guide to set up remote access for a list of available applications. Once this service has been set up, you will be able to access AxiUm Production, AxiUm Training, select Microsoft Office products linked to your account, and SharePoint via Internet Explorer browser. Using AxiUm through this service will now allow you to access MiPACS. Please note: the full desktop is NOT available through this set up, it only allows use of the programs listed.


**Step 1:** Get the Microsoft Remote Desktop app  from the App Store if you do not already have it. If you do already have it, make sure it is up to date!

**Step 2:** Launch the app once it's installed and you will see a bunch of options at the top bar of the program looking something like this:



Select Remote Resources.

**Step 3:** A new window will pop up:

Note: for the user name field, make sure you use '\ ' after 'dentistry' and NOT '/' It's easy to miss and can save you a headache.

**Step 4:** You should see a list of programs populate behind this window you just filled out. If you see them there, you can close the window and open them from there.
