

Migrating from Windows 7 to Windows 10

- All your files on your shared desktop will transfer over automatically.
- If you use internet explorer for bookmarks they should transfer over without issue.
- Some items will require actions steps on your behalf to migrate properly. ***see below***

Exporting Google Chrome bookmarks

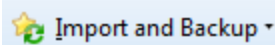
- Open google chrome and then press the following keys **[CTRL] + [Shift] + [O]**. This will open your bookmarks



In the top right hand corner of the browser you will see a circle icon. Click on the circle then select **[Export Bookmarks]**. Save the bookmarks to your Libraries -> Documents folder or USB drive. When you get your new computer you can go to the same location and select **[Import Bookmarks]** to get them back on your system.

Exporting Firefox bookmarks

- Open Firefox and press **[CTRL] + [Shift] + [B]**



Find the **[Import and Backup]** link then select backup. Save the files to your Libraries -> Documents folder or USB drive. On your new computer use the same steps but select restore to import your bookmarks.

Export your local files (if any...)

- Any files saved to the hard drive will not be imported, one good place to check is on your computers **C:\temp** folder.



Click on file explorer, locate your local files and copy them to either a portable drive (USB) or your **Libraries -> Documents** folder
