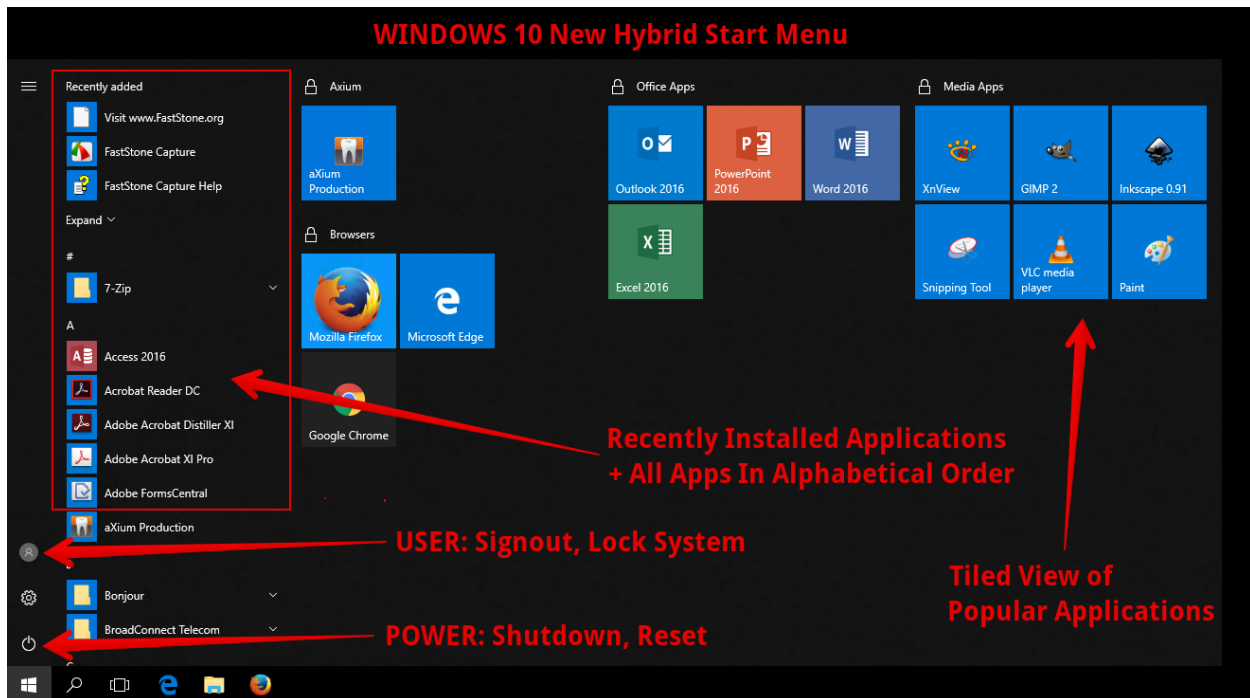


# Windows 10 – Overview

Welcome to Windows 10. This is a brief overview of some new features you will encounter. To log in use your normal Dentistry login and password. Please see this intro video for a more detailed walkthrough at <https://vimeo.com/279845317/9db54692cb>.



One of the biggest differences you may notice from Windows 7 is the Windows 10 “**Start Menu**” located on the bottom left hand corner. It is a hybrid of the Windows 7 Start Menu and the Windows 8 Start Screen. Left click on it to activate. Check out the image below for an overview of the new appearance.



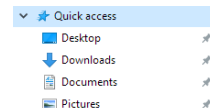
On the right side of the task bar there is a new feature called Task View that lets you create virtual desktops. Think of this as being able to create more monitors virtually.



When a program is running you will notice a blue underline underneath. This isn't the same as pinning the application. For pinning right click and select **[Pin To Taskbar]**.



The file explorer program lets you browse and interact with files. One new feature is the ability to pin programs or network shares to the quick access shortcuts. To add a pin item right click on the file or network share and select **[Pin To Quick access]**.
